THE GOAL OF THE PROGRAM: Our goal is to provide opportunities for children to have access to the water in an environment that supports their needs and provides an opportunity to learn water safety skills. **ALL SCHEDULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.**

The Environment of the Warm Water Pool

- Quiet and closed to other YMCA members
- Limited number of participants
- Pool heated up to 91 degrees
- NO whistles: Our staff uses alternative methods to communicate
- Toys: Noodles, Kickboards, Squeeze toys, Diving Rings
- 2 Lifeguards, 1 Deck Supervisor on deck
- 2 aquatic staff will be in the pool to help facilitate Safety & water skills

Safety & Participant Requirements:

- Max 10 individuals
- Ages 3-17 years old
- All participants must have a parent/guardian (18+) in the pool within arm's reach, at all times.
- If individual is not potty trained, they must wear a swim diaper
- All participants must wear a bathing suit
